**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Occidental of Elk Hills, Inc at the heavy oil production stationary source in the Western Kern County fields, California. The project authorizes the installation of new tanks, induced gas floatation vessels, Free Water Knockouts (FWKOs), heater treaters, and a produced gas flare. The emissions increase is 2154 lb/yr NO_x, 11,722 lb/yr CO, and 1,996 lb/yr VOC.

No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
