**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
EMISSION REDUCTION CREDITS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Chevron USA, Inc. for the shutdown of three gas turbine engines, at the North Midway Cogeneration facility in your western Kern County heavy oil production source. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 9,447 lb-NOx/yr, 51 lb-SOx/yr, 3,388 lb-PM10/yr, 6,356 lb-CO/yr, 1,077 lb-VOC/yr and 30,279 metric tons CO₂e/yr.
