FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Vintage Production California LLC at various unspecified locations within Vintage Production California's Light Oil Western Stationary Source in Kern County, California. These permits authorize the use of two transportable micro turbines to be operated at various unspecified locations within Vintage Production California's Light Oil Western Stationary Source in Kern County.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #S-1141816, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increases associated with this project are: 1,138 lb-NOx/year, 208 lb-VOC/year, 264 lb-PM10/year, 264 lb-PM2.5/year, 86 lb-SOx/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
