**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Chevron USA Inc at their light and heavy oil production stationary sources in the western Kern County oilfields. The project authorizes a new flare with emissions increases of 4,080 lb/yr NOx and 3,780 lb/yr VOC.

No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
