**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Chevron U.S.A. at their 26C, 31E, and 2F oil cleaning plants in the Midway Sunset Oilfield, California. Chevron USA has requested Authority to Construct permits for the installation of new crude oil processing tanks and vessels.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1134679, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increase associated with this project is: 31,630 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
