

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Evergreen Beverage Packaging at 1500 W Main St, Turlock, California. The applicant proposes to install a flexographic printing operation with a drying oven served by an existing waste paperboard pick-up system.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #N-1141880, is available for public inspection at [http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public\\_notices\\_idx.htm](http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm) and at any District office. There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. The applicant proposes an increase emissions in the following amounts: 526 lb-NOx/year, 15 lb-SOx/year, 60 lb-PM10/year, 442 lb-CO/year, 23,820 lb-VOC/year, and 988 lb-NH3/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
