**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Avenal Regional Landfill at 201 Hydril Rd, Avenal, California. The facility proposes to install a landfill gas collection and control system served by a flare.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #C-1132849, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The applicant proposes an increase emissions in the following amounts: 19,947 lb-NOx/year, 35,510 lb-SOx/year, 3,191 lb-PM10/year, 79,786 lb-CO/year, 35,876 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
