**NOTICE OF REVISED PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE PROPOSED RENEWAL OF  
A FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed renewal of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit for Badger Creek Limited at 535 Fano Avenue, Bakersfield, California.

The public notice for this permit renewal was first issued on May 27, 2014. However, based on a comment received from CARB, the application review and proposed renewed permit have been revised to address the requirements of 40 CFR Part 64 (Compliance Assurance Monitoring) for VOC emissions. Due to these revisions, the District is reissuing the public notice and an additional 45-day EPA review period.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #S-1133732, is available for public inspection at [http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public\\_notices\\_idx.htm](http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm) and at any District office. There are no emission changes associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the proposed renewal of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit.
