**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Berry Petroleum Company at the 21Z (McKittrick) lease, within Section 21, Township 30S, Range 22E. Berry Petroleum Company has requested Authority to Construct permits for two new steam generators.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1142135, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The proposed action results in the following annual emission increases: 11,914 pounds of NOx, 7446 pounds of SOx, 8190 pounds of PM10, 27,500 pounds of CO and 8190 pounds of VOC. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
