

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Chevron USA in western Fresno county. Chevron USA has requested Authority to Construct permits for seven new steam generators.

The emission Increase(s) associated with this project are: 44,304 lb-NOx/year, 14,854 lb-SOx/year, 16,679 lb-PM10/year, 16,679 lb-PM2.5/year, 96,425 lb-CO/year and 96,425 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
