NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Tri-City Growers, Inc for the shutdown of the cotton gin, at 18897 Ave 96, Terra Bella, CA 93720. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 283 lb-NOx/yr, 8 lb-SOx/yr, 8,869 lb-PM10/yr, 57 lb-CO/yr, 17 lb-VOC/yr and 167 metric tons CO2e/yr.
