

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Freeport McMoran Oil & Gas in western Kern county. The project authorized the installation of two steam generators.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1143358, is available for public inspection at [http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public\\_notices\\_idx.htm](http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm) and at any District office. The emissions increases associated with the project are 9,234 lb-NOx/year, 4,244 lb-SOx/year, 4,468 lb-PM10/year, 4,468 lb-PM2.5/year, 27,550 lb-CO/year, and 4,468 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
