FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of All American Oil and Gas at the Heavy Oil Central stationary source, California. All American Oil & Gas, Inc. is requesting to install two steam generators.

The emission increases associated with this project is/are: 9234 lb-NOx/year, 4244 lb-SOx/year, 4468 lb-PM10/year, 4468 lb-PM2.5/year, 22,040 lb-CO/year and 8190 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
