**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION
OF FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to Sensient Natural Ingredients LLC at 9984 W. Walnut Avenue, Livingston, California. The purpose of the project is to change the boiler's monitoring scheme from weekly oxygen (O₂) monitoring to monthly portable analyzer monitoring.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #N-1150216, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
