FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF  
EMISSION REDUCTION CREDITS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Chevron USA Inc. for the shutdown of one natural gas-fired engine powering a refrigerant compressor, at the Kettleman North Dome Oilfield in King's County. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 714 metric tons CO<sub>2</sub>e/yr.
