**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to issue Authorities to Construct to Chevron USA at the Heavy Oil Western stationary source, California. Chevron proposed to modify two 500 bbl crude oil tanks (Baker style) by increasing the throughput, increasing the TVP, and allowing the tank to operate at various unspecified locations.

No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
