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**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION  
OF FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to Bellaire Oil Company in central Kern County, California. The ATC authorized installation of a crude oil storage tank.

The emission increase associated with this project is 2604 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
