**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Linn Operating, Inc at 21Z Lease, Heavy Oil Western Stationary Source (Section 21, T30S, R22E), Kern County, California. The facility proposes to install one 5.67 MW cogeneration system at the 21Z lease in Heavy Oil Western Stationary Source, Kern County, CA (Section 21, T30S, R22E).

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #S-1151996, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increases associated with this project are: 9,932 lb-NOx/year, 2,341 lb-SOx/year, 18,597 lb-PM10/year, 18,597 lb-PM2.5/year, 15,121 lb-CO/year, 2,760 lb-VOC/year, and 4,992 lb-NH3/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
