Dear Mr. Ericksen:

The Air Pollution Control Officer has issued Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) to Chevron USA. Inc. for emission reductions generated by the shutdown of one natural gas-fired engine powering a refrigerant compressor, at the Kettleman North Dome Oilfield in King's County. The quantity of ERCs to be issued is 714 metric tons CO2e/vr.

Enclosed are the ERC Certificates and a copy of the notice of final action to be published approximately three days from the date of this letter.

Notice of the District's preliminary decision to issue the ERC Certificates was published on 8/28/15. The District's analysis of the proposal was also sent to CARB and US EPA Region IX on 8/25/15. No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
