

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Olam West Coast Inc at Firebaugh, California. This project authorizes the installation of a new vegetable milling operation and a new vegetable dehydrator and an increase in the combined annual emissions limit.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #C-1152363, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increases associated with this project are: 14,265 lb-NOx/year, 1,143 lb-SOx/year, 6,170 lb-PM10/year, 6,170 lb-PM2.5/year, 112,070 lb-CO/year and 1,299 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
