Dear Ms. Grant:

The Air Pollution Control Officer has issued Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) to Chevron U.S.A. Inc. for emission reductions generated by reducing the permitted operation of four gas turbine engines, at their Kern River Oilfield facility located at Section 31, Township 28S, Range 28E. The quantity of ERCs to be issued is 56,617 lb-NOx/yr.

Sycamore Cogeneration Co has requested that the ERCs be issued to their parent company Chevron U.S.A. Inc. As such, enclosed is the ERC Certificate issued to Chevron U.S.A., Inc. and a copy of the notice of final action to be published approximately three days from the date of this letter.

Notice of the District's preliminary decision to issue the ERC Certificates was published on June 6, 2014. The District's analysis of the proposal was also sent to CARB and US EPA Region IX on May 28, 2014. No comments were received following the District's preliminary decision on this project.
