

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Golden State Vintners at 7409 W Central Ave in Fresno, California. The modifications consist of limiting gasoline throughput not to exceed 18,000 gallon per year in order to be exempt from California Air Resource Board's (CARB's) Phase I Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) upgrade requirements and changing testing frequency of the Dynamic Back Pressure Test (TP-201.4) from once every 12 months to once every 5 years.

There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
