

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Highway 59 Landfill at 7040 N Highway 59, Merced, California. This modification is to limit the annual gasoline throughput to not exceed 18,000 gallons per year in order to be exempt from California Air Resources Board's (ARB's) Phase I Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) system upgrade requirements.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #N-1153193, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
