

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION  
OF FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to E&J Gallo Winery - Livingston at 18000 River Road, Livingston, California. These Authorities to Construct (ATC) permits were issued for the installation of two cogeneration (heat and electric) systems each equipped with 1,393 bhp Cummins Model QSK60G lean burn digester gas-fired internal combustion (IC) engine.

The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 7,738 lb-NOx/year, 1,290 lb-SOx/year, 1,702 lb-PM10/year, 1,702 lb-PM2.5/year, 41,274 lb-CO/year and 5,160 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
