THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Kern Oil and Refining Co. at 7724 E Panama Lane in Bakersfield, California. The application is for a new sulfur recovery unit.

The emission increase associated with this project is: 448 lb-SOx/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
