**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION
OF FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to California Resources Production Corp. at the Light Oil Western Stationary Source, Kern County, California. This project authorizes the modification of three natural gas-fired IC engines to lower the NOx emission limit to 11 ppmv @ 15% O2 for Rule 4702 compliance. In addition, the facility has requested to remove the manometer recording requirement from permit S-1738-60 and the non-resettable fuel flow meter requirement from permits S-1738-124 and '-345.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1153092, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
