**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED MODIFICATION OF
FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to modify the Federally Mandated Operating Permit for California Resources Production Corp. located within the Light Oil Western Stationary Source in Kern County, CA. This project authorizes the modification of three natural gas-fired IC engines to lower the NOx emission limit to 11 ppmv @ 15% O2 for Rule 4702 compliance. In addition, the facility requested to remove the manometer recording requirement from permit S-1738-60 and the non-resettable fuel flow meter requirement from permits S-1738-124 and '-345.
