**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of E&B Natural Resources in western Kern County, California. The application is for two steam generators.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1171635, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increases associated with this project are: 9,234 lb-NOx/year, 4,244 lb-SOx/year, 5,212 lb-PM10/year, 5,212 lb-PM2.5/year, 27,550 lb-CO/year and 0 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
