THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Land O Lakes Inc at 400 South M St, Tulare, California. The project authorizes a new boiler.

The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 8,645 lb-NOx/year, 4,458 lb-SOx/year, 12,027 lb-PM10/year, 12,027 lb-PM2.5/year, 57,190 lb-CO/year and 8,169 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
