

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED RENEWAL OF
THE FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed renewal of the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to Chemical Waste Management, Inc. at 35251 Old Skyline Rd, Kettleman City, California.

This is the second notice related to this project. The District has learned that some interested parties received the first notice for this project late into the original commenting period. Therefore, to provide the public with sufficient time to review and respond to the District's proposal, the District is extending the opportunity to provide public comments for an additional 30 day period.

There are no emission changes associated with this proposed action.
