

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Stratford Growers, LLC for the shut down of the cotton gin, at 19813 Madison Ave, Stratford. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 1st quarter: 107 lb-NOx, 12 lb-SOx, 828 lb-PM10, 15 lb-CO, and 4 lb-VOC; and 4th quarter: 1,195 lb-NOx, 130 lb-SOx, 9,223 lb-PM10, 168 lb-CO, and 44 lb-VOC; and 598 metric tons-CO2e/yr.
