THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of E&B Natural Resources in central Kern county, California. The Authorities to Construct permits are for the installation of five steam generators.

The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 23,085 lb-NOx/year, 10,610 lb-SOx/year, 13,030 lb-PM10/year, 13,030 lb-PM2.5/year, 68,875 lb-CO/year and 20,475 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
