

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Bronco Wine Company at 6342 Bystrum Road, Ceres, California. The proposed project is to establish a combined total VOC emissions limit for wine storage tanks operating under permits N-1665-497 through '-506, and '-508 through '-513. This combined total VOC emission limit will replace the existing annual throughput limit in each permit.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project # N-1172886, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. There are no emission increase in permitted emissions under District's Rule 2201 with the proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
