FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of E&B Natural Resources in central Kern County, California. The permits are for five steam generators.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project # S-1184033, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 23,085 lb-NOx/year, 10,610 lb-SOx/year, 13,030 lb-PM10/year, 13,030 lb-PM2.5/year, and 60,875 lb-CO/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
