

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Scelzi Enterprises Inc. at 2772 S. Cherry Avenue, Fresno, California. This project authorizes the modification of seven motor vehicle and mobile equipment coating operations to convert the existing daily facility-wide VOC emission limit of 149.0 lb/day to an equivalent annual facility-wide VOC emission limit of 54,385 lb/year and to make other minor changes to the permitted PM10 emission limits.

There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
