**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Chevron USA, Inc. at Chevron's Heavy Oil Central Stationary Source in Kern County, California. The project involves one new emergency IC engine powering an electrical generator.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project # S-1192124, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increases associated with this project are: 919 lb-NO_x/year, 1 lb-SO_x/year, 22 lb-PM₁₀/year, 22 lb-PM_{2.5}/year, 163 lb-CO/year and 46 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
