

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

DRAFT 2003 PM10 PLAN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that public workshops will be held to present, discuss, and receive comments on the Draft 2003 PM10 Plan (PM10 Plan). In addition, the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District) will hold a separate Technical Workshop emphasizing air quality modeling conducted for the PM10 Plan.

The PM10 Plan is the District's strategy for achieving the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for particulate matter measuring less than 10 microns in diameter (PM10). The plan is designed to meet the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act (CAA) and contains measures needed to attain the NAAQS at the earliest possible date. The PM10 Plan will become part of the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the San Joaquin Valley.
