

RULE 5150 CONTINUANCES (Adopted May 21, 1992; Amended December 17, 1992;
Amended December 16, 1993)

1.0 Requirements

In the event that a quorum of the Hearing Board is not present, the Chairperson or any member of the Hearing Board shall continue the scheduled hearing for up to 30 days. The Hearing Board may continue any hearing upon a showing of good cause. The Hearing Board may grant a continuance for a reasonable length of time upon submission of a stipulation signed by all interested parties, including the petitioner, the APCO, and all persons who have filed an answer in the action at issue. Such stipulations may be submitted ex parte before the scheduled hearing, without a meeting of the Hearing Board and without prior notice.
