**NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP ON TECHNICAL ISSUES
IN DEVELOPING AN OZONE ATTAINMENT DEMONSTRATION PLAN FOR
SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY AIR BASIN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public workshop will be held to present information regarding technical issues associated with development of the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District's (Valley Air District) Ozone Attainment Demonstration Plan. This Ozone Attainment Demonstration Plan sets forth the emission reductions and timeline for attaining the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for ozone (1-hr standard) in the San Joaquin Valley Air Basin (SJVAB). Staff of the Valley Air District will make presentations on ozone formation and effects, emission inventory development, air quality modeling, control strategy development, and related planning issues such as the implementation of the 8-hour ozone NAAQS and the SJVAB's ozone attainment status. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and comment on the material presented.
