

**San Joaquin Valley Unified
Air Pollution Control District is seeking**

HEARING BOARD MEMBERS

The San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District has three Hearing Boards which hold monthly hearings and make decisions on: variance applications pertaining to air quality rules and regulations affecting business and industry in the Valley; appeals to permits; orders of abatement, and revocations of permits.

There are:

- Two vacancies on the Central Region Hearing Board: (2) Public Alternate positions.

- Four vacancies on the Northern Region Hearing Board: (1) Medical Alternate position, (1) Attorney Alternate position, (1) Engineer Alternate position and (1) Public Alternate position.

- Five vacancies on the Southern Region Hearing Board: (1) Attorney Primary position, (1) Attorney Alternate position, (1) Engineer Alternate position and (2) Public Alternate positions.

The regions are comprised of the following counties:

Central Region: Fresno, Kings and Madera

Northern Region: Merced, San Joaquin and Stanislaus

Southern Region: Kern and Tulare.

If you can attend a monthly meeting and meet the requirement of one of the vacant positions:

- A medical professional whose specialized skills, training, or interests are in the fields of environmental medicine, community medicine, or occupational/toxicologic medicine.
- A professional engineer registered as such pursuant to the Professional Engineers Act (Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 6700) of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code).
- Admitted to the practice of law in this state.
- A member of the public.
