

**NOTICE OF THE UPCOMING  
TRAINING COURSE FOR THE  
CERTIFICATION OF AIR PERMITTING PROFESSIONALS (CAPP)**

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District) will be conducting a two-day training course for new CAPP candidates. The CAPP course is designed as a review of District permitting programs, policies and procedures for experienced environmental permitting professionals and is not intended as an introductory training course. Prior experience is required for acceptance into the CAPP program, as detailed in District Rule 1170.

This two-day course will be held at the following time and location:

May 1 & 2, 2013 (Wednesday and Thursday)

To become CAPP certified, candidates must also pass a four-hour exam that will be given on Thursday, June 6, 2013 at 8:30 AM in Fresno. This is the only day the exam will be offered.

CAPP program candidates must send a complete CAPP training application form to the District by April 22, 2013 by 5:00 PM. Only the two-day mandatory CAPP course (\$374) will be offered and not the voluntary sessions. The District will review all applications and notify candidates if they are eligible to attend this training course. Class assignment is limited and will be based on the date of receipt of the complete application.
