## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP**

On January 2, 2014 the California Air Pollution Control Officers Association (CAPCOA) established a Greenhouse Gas Reduction Exchange (GHG Rx). The GHG Rx is a registry and information exchange for greenhouse gas emissions reduction credits designed specifically to benefit the state of California. The GHG Rx is a trusted source of locally generated credits from projects within California, and facilitates communication between those who create the credits, potential buyers, and funding organizations. Anticipated users of the GHG Rx include lead agencies and other government agencies, credit owners and credit project developers, land use developers, businesses, non-profit organizations, and individuals.
