On March 23, 2017, the California Air Resources Board adopted California's Oil and Gas Regulation (Greenhouse Gas Emission Standards for Crude Oil and Natural Gas Facilities, 17 CCR Section 95665 et seq.). The requirements of this Regulation became effective on January 1, 2018.

On December 21, 2017, to assist facilities to comply with the California's Oil and Gas Regulation, the District adopted Rule 2260 Registration Requirements for Equipment Subject to California's Oil and Gas Regulation. Rule 2260 required that owners or operators of facilities subject to California's Regulation submit registration applications by March 1, 2018 and an inventory of all equipment by July 1, 2018.

Recently, affected facilities and industry groups have requested that the District hold a meeting to assist facilities in understanding and complying with Rule 2260 and California's Oil and Gas Regulation. **Therefore, the District will be holding a meeting on September 11, 2018 to assist facilities understanding how to comply with the requirements of Rule 2260 and California's Oil and Gas Regulation. Topics to be discussed include: the administrative requirements of Rule 2260, and the standards, leak detection and repair requirements, and limited exemptions contained in California's Oil and Gas Regulation.**
