### Other 2012 Projects

**Rule 1020 (Definitions):** Rule amendments would incorporate dimethyl carbonate and propylene carbonate to the list of exempt compounds because EPA has designated these materials as compounds with very low ozone-forming potential.

**Status:** A public review period will be scheduled at a later date.

Governing Board Hearing: Second quarter 2012

**2012 PM2.5 Plan:** This plan will demonstrate how the San Joaquin Valley will expeditiously attain the federal PM2.5 standard adopted in 2006. This is a challenging standard that is expected to require additional regulatory control measure commitments as well as creative use of incentive funding and policy initiatives to achieve more emissions reductions. Both sound science and the District's Risk-based Strategy will be integrated with every stage of analysis for this plan, which must be submitted through ARB to EPA by December 14, 2012. The District will also incorporate contingency analysis required by the District's 2008 adoption of the Rule 4901 (Wood Burning Fireplaces and Wood Burning heaters) contingency measure.

**Status:** Foundational analysis is in progress. The District expects to hold public workshops starting in April 2012.
