The CAC requested clarification on tonnage of PM reductions achieved during the first season of Rule 4901 wood burning curtailment program which ran from November through the end of February.

The Chair requested an item be added to the May 4, 2004 CAC Agenda regarding information on tonnage of PM reductions achieved as a result of the end of the first season of the wood burning curtailment program.

The CAC requested a copy of the Request For Proposal (RFP) or the agreement, regarding the selection of the recommended vendor for advertising agency representation for the comprehensive bilingual public outreach campaign.

Mr. Sadredin stated that District staff and a representative from the advertising agency will attend a future CAC meeting to make a presentation to the CAC to seek their advice and input on the District's outreach campaign.

The Chair requested an item pertaining to the bilingual public outreach campaign be included on the May 4, 2004 CAC Agenda.

The CAC stated staff should contact Pacific Ethanol to participate in a agenda item regarding fuel cell technology at the May 4 meeting.

The CAC made a request regarding the District Highlights Report. The CAC requested that in the future the District's Heavy-Duty Engine Monthly Statistics report be revised by breaking down the total number of engines into categories for On-Road, Off-Road and Agricultural Pumps.
