- 5. <u>Approve Minutes of Tuesday, April 4, 2000</u> The Chair stated that the Minutes of Tuesday, April 4, 2000 were approved as submitted.
- 6. Rules Under Development Joe Nazareno, Senior Air Quality Engineer, reported on Rules Under Development.
- 4. <u>APCO Comments</u> David L. Crow, Executive Director/APCO, commented on Federal, State and District activities.

Mr. Crow announced that on June 5, 2000 at Chandler Airport, Fresno, 1:30 p.m. a news conference will be held. This is a kickoff introduction of the next round of an air quality study that will be undertaken in the Central part of California. Mr.

Crow noted that this is a very significant scientific undertaking that parallels the research that has been done over the last decade.

Mr. Crow announced that copies of the District's Recommended Budget for 2000-2001 were available in the Central, Northern and Southern offices if the CAC would like a copy. The Recommended Budget will on the May 18, 2000, Governing Board meeting agenda for the Public Hearing to discuss and then again on the June 15, 2000, Governing Board meeting agenda for the Public Hearing for adoption.
