- 3. <u>Chair Comments</u> The Chair welcomed a new CAC Member: Ms. Ann Williams representing Kern County as the Environmental Primary Member.
- 4. APCO Comments David L. Crow, Executive Director/APCO, reported on actions taken by the Governing Board at their January 17, 2002 meeting. Mr. Crow noted that the 2002 Chair for the Governing Board is Councilmember Sam Armentrout and the 2002 Vice Chair is Supervisor Ronn Dominici. Mr. Crow announced that the Board adopted proposed amendments to Rule 4354 (Glass Melting Furnaces). Accepted Carl Moyer Program funds in the amount of \$2,757,263 from ARB to be placed in the District's Heavy-Duty Engine Emission Reduction Incentive Program. Received a Legislative Update from Dale Wagerman, Wagerman Associates, Inc. Mr. Crow noted that the Board received a report on Public Comments received in workshops on the 2002 Amendments to the San Joaquin Valley Ozone Plan and the severe versus extreme nonattainment classification that were held on January 8, 9 and 16, 2002.
