**CENTRAL REGION HEARING BOARD MEETING** 

On September 28, 2009, Hearing Board Vice Chair Robert Schumacher approved an emergency variance from September 29, 2009 until October 4, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4101, 4201, 4202, 4354, and 4801 and allowed the continued operation of the glass melting furnace while the exhaust gas bypasses the electrostatic precipitator.

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## C. <u>Docket C-09-20E</u> – PG&E Helms Headquarters

On September 29, 2009, Hearing Board Chair Jerry Boren approved an emergency variance from October 6, 2009 until October 7, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4702 and allowed the operation of two diesel fired emergency electrical generators during a non-emergency event.

## D. <u>Docket C-09-21E</u> – Chevron USA, Inc.

On October 1, 2009, Hearing Board Chair Jerry Boren approved an emergency variance from October 1, 2009 until October 6, 2009.
