On December 1, 2009, Hearing Board Chair Jerry Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from December 1, 2009 to December 4, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4101, 4201, 4202, and 4354 and allowed the continued operation of the glass melting furnace while the exhaust gas bypasses the electrostatic precipitator and the associated CEMS/COMS on the stack.
