5. The Central Region Hearing Board has heard and granted the following emergency variances since the September 16, 2015, hearing:

A. <u>Docket C-15-23E</u> – CertainTeed Corporation

On September 29, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry K. Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 28, 2015, to October 3, 2015. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and 4354 and allowed for continued glass manufacturing with excess visible emissions while the exhaust stream bypasses the pre-conditioning chamber, caustic soda injection, EP, and CEMS so that the shorted transformer on the EP could be replaced.

B. <u>Docket C-15-25E</u> – Guardian Industries Corp

On October 1, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry K. Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 1, 2015, through October 5, 2015. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and 4354 and allowed for continued glass manufacturing with excess visible emissions while the exhaust stream bypasses the scrubber, EP, and SCR so that maintenance can be performed on the EP.
